In the event of such a problem, it may become necessary to impose production restrictions on this well.

The exception is valid for ninety (90) days from the date the exception is granted. If a well is not drilled within those 90 days, the property owner may apply for one ninety (90) day extension.

EXCEPTIONS MAY BE GRANTED FOR TRACTS OF LAND LESS THAN FIVE (5) CONTIGUOUS ACRES, AND WHICH WERE THE RESULT OF A SUBDIVISION OF PROPERTY TAKING PLACE BEFORE JANUARY 1ST, 2004.

The application shall be submitted with the \$10.00 application fee and should be accompanied by a plat, or sketch drawn to scale of one (1) inch equaling two hundred (200) yards. The plat or sketch shall show thereon the property lines in the immediate area and shall show accurately to scale the location of the three (3) nearest wells within one-half (1/2) mile of the proposed well location. The application shall also contain the names and addresses of all property owners adjoining the tract on which the well is to be located, within one-half (1/2) mile, and the owners of the three (3) nearest wells within one-half (1/2) mile of the proposed well location.

NOTES: If the Board grants an exception to the District Rules for a proposed new well, the applicant is still required to apply for a permit prior to drilling if the proposed well does not meet the definition of an exempt well, and must be completed in accordance and in compliance with the standards of the Texas Water Well Drillers and Water Well Pump Installers Rules.

By the granting of this exception, the Board does not guarantee or imply to the property owner that a well on this property will be able to sufficiently supply the needs of the property owner, nor does it guarantee or imply to the property owner that production from this well will not negatively affect other wells in the area. In the event of such a problem, a well granted an exception is subject to the placement of pumping restrictions.
