

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Attention all Public Water Suppliers, Irrigators, Commercial Business Owners, and other Large Volume Water Consumers/Producers

The August 1, 2007 deadline to apply for Existing and Historic Use Permits (EHUP) on your existing water wells is fast approaching. After August 1, all permits will fall under the rules of our Standard Operating Permit process and **the District will no longer accept any EHUP applications.**

Existing and Historic Use Permits offer many benefits to the well owner:

1. No application fees
2. Larger volumes of water may be permitted due to historic use
3. During drought, EHUP holders are curtailed only as a last resort
4. No production fees for existing and historic agricultural users

Please, do not let this one time only opportunity pass by.

The Fayette County Groundwater Conservation District staff is available to speak to your business or organization about Existing and Historic Use Permitting.
