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MINUTES of the August 1, 2011, 8:30 A.M., Public Hearing

The public hearing was called to order by President Wick at 8:34 a.m., on August 1, 2011 at the Fayette County Agricultural Building Conference Room 104, located at 255 Svoboda Lane, in La Grange, Texas. A quorum to conduct business was declared to be present. Items to be considered during the public hearing:

P-2011-005	City of La Grange-Well #8	121.44 acre feet/year
P-2011-006	City of La Grange- Well #9	121.44 acre feet/year
P-2011-007	Mike Teinert	160 acre feet/year

Mr. Van Dresar gave his recommendation to the board regarding the City of La Grange permit application P-2011-005. Van Dresar stated that the well will be used as a public water supply for the City of La Grange and based on the information received the well will be completed in the Yegua-Jackson aquifer. Mr. Van Dresar stated that district records indicate that water is available for permitting in the Yegua-Jackson. Van Dresar advised the board that the city requested that this well and well #9 be placed in aggregate.

Mr. Leer questioned the reason for two wells on the property. Mr. Schmidt stated that production in one well may not be able to produce the full amount. He stated that the second well gives the city redundancy. After a brief discussion, Mr. Leer made the motion to grant the permit. Mr. Hays seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mr. Van Dresar gave his recommendation to the board regarding the City of La Grange permit application P-2011-006. Mr. Van Dresar stated that the well will be used as a public water supply well for the City of La Grange and based on the information received the well will be completed in the Yegua-Jackson aquifer. Van Dresar stated that district records indicate that water is available

for permitting in the Yegua-Jackson. Van Dresar stated that the city requested that this well be placed in aggregate with well #8.

Mr. Leer asked a question regarding total production. Mr. Van Dresar stated that the permits allow for production of a combined total of 241.88 acre feet. Van Dresar advised the board that the production total would not be allowed to exceed the 2 acre foot per acre rule of the district. After a brief discussion, Mr. Hays made the motion to grant the permit. Mr. Richter seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mr. Van Dresar gave his recommendation to the board regarding Mike Teinert s' permit application P-2011-007. Van Dresar stated that the well will be used as a water supply to irrigate pasture land and based on the information received the well will be completed in the Alluvium aquifer. Mr. Van Dresar stated that district records indicate that water is available for permitting in the Alluvium. Van Dresar advised the board that a permit was granted to Mr. Paul Teinert in July that will be 1,316 feet from Mike Teinert s' well, but that the proposed location of the well is in compliance with separation distances required in the district rules.

There being not further discussion, Mr. Leer made the motion to grant the permit. Mr. Hays seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

There being no further items on the agenda, President Wick adjourned the Public Hearing at 8:58 a.m.
