MINUTES of the February 1, 2010, 8:30 A.M., Public Hearing Concerning an Application for One Operating Permit Submitted by Patrick Simar

The public hearing was called to order by President Calley at 8:31 a.m. on February 1, 2010 at the Fayette County Agricultural Building Conference Room 104, located at 255 Svoboda Lane, in La Grange, Texas. A quorum to conduct business was declared to be present. Items to be considered during the public hearing:

A-P-2010-001 Patrick Simar 9.21 acre feet/year

President Calley asked for any public comments. There were none.

Mr. Van Dresar gave the staff recommendation to the Board. Van Dresar stated that the well will be used for irrigating trees and, based on the information received, the well will be completed in the Yegua-Jackson aquifer. Mr. Van Dresar stated that district records indicate that water is available for permitting in the Yegua-Jackson.

Mr. Finke stated that irrigation would be through small drip type irrigator tips. Samples of the drip devices were given to the Board for inspection.

There being no further discussion, Mr. Leer made the motion to grant the permit to Mr. Simar. Mr. Kainer seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

There being no further items on the agenda, President Calley adjourned the Public Hearing at 8:37 a.m.
