MINUTES of the November 1, 2010, 8:30 A.M., Public Hearing Concerning an Amendment Application for Water Well Operating Permit P-2010-004

The public hearing was called to order by President Calley at 8:30 a.m., on November 1, 2010 at the Fayette County Agricultural Building Conference Room 104, located at 255 Svoboda Lane, in La Grange, Texas. A quorum to conduct business was declared to be present. Items to be considered during the public hearing:

P-2010-004 Colorado River Cowboy Church Amend permit from water supply to irrigation

There were no public comments.

Mr. Van Dresar gave his recommendation to the Board. Van Dresar stated that the applicant is requesting an amendment to permit P-2010-004 from water supply to irrigation. Mr. Van Dresar stated that the amendment application indicated that the reasoning for the requested amendment was that the initial application was completed incorrectly. Van Dresar stated that there is no request to increase or decrease the production from the well. He also stated that the well that was completed for the church did not meet TCEQ standards for a public water supply well and this is the only alternative that the church would have to utilize the well. Van Dresar stated that there was no information as to how potable water would be supplied to the church, and recommended that the board require the church to provide the district with documentation or plans as to how it will supply water to the church building.

After a brief discussion, Mr. Leer made the motion to grant the amendment to the permit and to also require the church to submit documentation to the district as to how it will supply potable water to the church. Mr. Kainer seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

There being no further items on the agenda, President Calley adjourned the Public Hearing at 8:47 a.m.
