MINUTES of the August 2, 2010, 8:30 A.M., Public Hearing Concerning an Application for One Operating Permit Submitted by Jill E. Stueber and One Operating Permit Submitted by the Colorado River Cowboy Church

The public hearing was called to order by President Calley at 8:30 a.m. on August 2, 2010 at the Fayette County Agricultural Building Conference Room 104, located at 255 Svoboda Lane, in La Grange, Texas. A quorum to conduct business was declared to be present. Items to be considered during the public hearing:

A-P-2010-003	Jill E. Stueber	4.48 acre feet/year
A-P-2010-004	Colorado River Cowboy Church	0.767 acre feet/year

President Calley asked for any public comments. There were none.

Regarding Ms. Stueber's permit application, Mr. Van Dresar gave the staff recommendation to the Board. Van Dresar stated that the well will be used as a public water supply for a restaurant and, based on the information received; the well will be completed in the Jasper aquifer. Mr. Van Dresar stated that district records indicate that water is available for permitting in the Jasper.

There being no further discussion, Mr. Leer made the motion to grant the permit to Ms. Stueber. Mr. Wick seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Regarding the Colorado River Cowboy Church permit application, Mr. Van Dresar gave the staff recommendation to the Board. Mr. Van Dresar stated that the well will be used as a water supply for a church and, based on the information received; the well will be completed in the Sparta aquifer. Mr. Van Dresar stated that records indicated that water is available for permitting in the Sparta.

There being no further discussion, Mr. Richter made the motion to grant the permit to the Colorado River Cowboy Church. Mr. Leer seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

There being no further items on the agenda, President Calley adjourned the Public Hearing at 8:38 a.m.
