MINUTES of the January 7, 2008 8:30 A.M. Public Hearing Concerning Applications for Operating Permits Submitted by Fugro Properties, Inc. dba Fugro Data Solutions, Inc. and David Loesch

President Schneider asked for public comments and/or questions regarding the Fugro Data Solutions, Inc. application being considered. There were no public comments, for or against, the Fugro Data Solutions, Inc. application. Mr. Calley made the motion to grant the operating permit to Fugro Data Solutions, Inc. Mr. Kainer seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, President Schneider called for a vote on the motion. The motion was approved.

President Schneider asked for public comments and/or questions regarding the David Loesch applications being considered. There were no public comments, for or against, any of the applications submitted by Mr. Loesch. The Board deliberated the use of the water wells referenced in the two applications. After considerable discussion it was found that the uses of the water wells were for domestic use and exempt from permitting. Mr. Calley made the motion to deny the operating permits to Mr. Loesch as the Board considered the uses as domestic. Mr. Brunner seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, President Schneider called for a vote on the motion. The motion was approved.

There being no further items on the agenda, the public hearing was adjourned at 8:55 a.m.
