

MINUTES
of the September 7, 2010, 8:30 A.M.,
Public Hearing Concerning an Application for One
Operating Permit Submitted by
the City of Schulenburg

The public hearing was called to order by President Calley immediately following the 8:30 a.m. public hearing on the district s'proposed tax rate, on September 7, 2010 at the Fayette County Agricultural Building Conference Room 104, located at 255 Svoboda Lane, in La Grange, Texas. A quorum to conduct business was declared to be present. Items to be considered during the public hearing:

A-P-2010-005 City of Schulenburg 200 acre feet/year

President Calley asked for any public comments. There were none.

Mr. Van Dresar gave the staff recommendation to the Board. Van Dresar stated that the well will be used as a public water supply for the City of Schulenburg and, based on the information received; the well will be completed in the Yegua Jackson aquifer. Mr. Van Dresar stated that district records indicate that water is available for permitting in the Yegua Jackson.

Mr. Schmidt asked that the permit state that the well could be completed in either the Jasper or the Yegua Jackson aquifer instead of limiting the permit to just the Yegua Jackson. Mr. Schmidt stated that the well may be completed in the shallower Jasper aquifer once testing is completed on the well. Mr. Calley asked how the district would know that the well is screened in only one aquifer. Mr. Wick and Mr. Van Dresar replied that the well driller s'log will indicate where the screens are set. Mr. Schmidt stated that if the well is completed in the Jasper aquifer, the well would be sealed up to the aquifer. If the well will be completed in the Yegua Jackson aquifer then the well would be pressure concreted at the Jasper aquifer. Mr. Schmidt stated that he would not risk his license and that the well would be properly completed. There being no further discussion, Mr. Richter made the motion to grant the permit with the language regarding completing the well

in either the Jasper or the Yegua Jackson, but not both, to the City of Schulenburg. Mr. Kainer seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

There being no further items on the agenda, President Calley adjourned the Public Hearing at 8:46 a.m.
