MINUTES of the September 12, 2011, 8:30 A.M., Public Hearing

The public hearing was called to order by President Wick at 8:30 a.m., on September 12, 2011 at the Fayette County Agricultural Building Conference Room 104, located at 255 Svoboda Lane, in La Grange, Texas. A quorum to conduct business was declared to be present. Items to be considered during the public hearing:

P-2011-008 Sara M. Blanchard 120 acre feet/year

Mr. Van Dresar gave his recommendation to the board regarding Mrs. Blanchard s' permit application P-2011-008. Van Dresar stated that the well is an existing water well to be used as an irrigation well for 60 acres of pasture located on 600 acres of property owned by the J.E. Morgan Trust. Mr. Van Dresar stated that, based on the information received, the well is completed in the Yegua-Jackson aquifer. Mr. Van Dresar stated that district records indicate that water is available for permitting in the Yegua-Jackson.

There was a brief discussion on why a permit hearing was needed if there is no reason to not grant the permits to applicants. Following the discussion, Mr. Leer made the motion to grant the permit. Mr. Hayek seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

There being no further items on the agenda, President Wick adjourned the Public Hearing at 8:45 a.m.
