Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Fayette County Groundwater Conservation District (the District) is considering amendments and new rules to its District Rules and will conduct a public rule-making hearing on the proposed Amended and New District Rules at the District's public Board meeting that is scheduled for Monday, November 6, 2006 beginning at 8:30 a.m. at the District's Office located at 254 N. Jefferson St., Room 600, La Grange, Texas 78945. Public comment or information on the proposed amendments and new rules will be received at that time.

A brief explanation of the proposed amendments and new rules is: 1) amendments to clarify language in various rules; 2) additional definitions; 3) amendments to conform to recent changes in legislative requirements; 4) new rules concerning test hole permits; 5) new rules concerning Existing and Historic Use Permits; and 6) additional amendments and new rules.
