MINUTES

Of the September 3, 2025 Board of Directors Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Brothers at 9:41 a.m., on September 4, 2025, at the Fayette County Agricultural Building Conference Room 104 located at 255 Svoboda Lane, in La Grange, Texas. A quorum to conduct business was declared to be present.

Mr. Heinrich gave the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Brothers asked if there were any public comments. There were none.

Minutes from the August 4, 2025 Board of Directors meeting were presented by Mrs. Labus. Mrs. Rodibaugh made the motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Heinrich seconded the motion and the motion was approved.

Mrs. Labus presented the August 2025 financial statements. Mrs. Labus made a note that the interest earned for the month of July was corrected to reflect the correct amount. Mr. Wick made the motion to approve the financial statements and to pay the outstanding bills. Mrs. Rodibaugh seconded the motion and it was approved.

Mrs. Labus presented the contract with the Fayette County Appraisal District to collect the District's taxes. Mr. Heinrich made the motion to approve the contract. Mrs. Rodibaugh seconded the motion and it was approved.

The proposed budget was presented by Mrs. Labus for discussion. Mr. Labus noted adjustments she made that reduced the overall budget and after some discussion on the purchase of a new vehicle it was decided to not include it in the budget and discuss at a later date. Mrs. Labus did provide the requested quotes and information from the last meeting. Mrs. Labus stated that staff was satisfied that the budget presented was sufficient to meet the financial needs of the district for the next fiscal year.

Mrs. Labus presented the proposed FY 2025-2026 budget for approval. Mr. Wick made the motion to approve the proposed budget. Mrs. Rodibaugh seconded the motion and it was approved.

Mrs. Norman presented the legislative updates as required.

Mrs. Norman presented updates and revisions to the District Rules for discussion. Several items discussed were the concerns with subdivision tracts and wells, verifying meter installation on permitted wells and requiring a port access by well drillers on new wells.

August 27, Region K Water Planning Group held a meeting in Austin. The meeting was to discuss and approve written comments from the public and other entities regarding the initially prepared plan (IPP) for the region, grant the consultant authority to make minor correction to the document, and complete the final prepared plan for approval at the September 2025 meeting.
