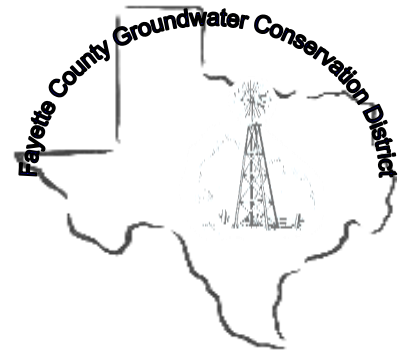


# Fayette County Groundwater Conservation District

### NAVIGATING THE FAYETTE COUNTY GCD WEBSITE

Did you know that you can go to our website at [www.fayettecountygroundwater.com](http://www.fayettecountygroundwater.com) and see if your water well is registered and/or see any information the District has on your well? Well you can!!!

Our website has a lot of helpful information on it. For instance, when our next Board of Director's meeting will be. You can find all of our Agendas and Minutes from the meetings. Looking for a Well Driller? Just click on the Helpful Information tab and you can find a list of all well drillers that currently drill in Fayette County.

The best part about our website is you can click on the Registered Wells tab, click the link and it will open up a map of Fayette County. You can type in your address and it will zoom right to it. If your well is registered and we have a latitude and longitude it will show up on your property. You can click on the star, and it will give you all the information we have on your well.

Thinking about drilling a new well? Did you know you have to file an Application for Registration before the well can be drilled? Now you can do that online on the website!!! Curious about the depths of wells in your area? You can use the map on the website to see the depths, water levels (if available) and water quality (if available) of other wells. Just click on the star that is on the property near you, and all the information will be there.

Don't see a star on your property but you have a water well? Give us a call and we can get it registered (which is required by law). Think you have a registered water well but still don't see a star? Give us a call, we may have the registration but don't have the coordinates to place the well. (We'd really appreciate that!)

We encourage you to browse through the website. All of our Forms are available for download on our website. The water testing form is available on there also! You can read about our Director's and our Staff, you can find Kid's pages, check the rainfall totals, see what's happening at the District and best of all, you can chat with us! Our website is live, so while you are browsing, if you have any questions just click on the chat button and we'll say hello!
